**Location:** Fly to Sydney airport. Take the airport train to Central Station change and catch the train (T1 North Shore, Northern and Western). Knox Senior Secondary Academy is a 3 minute walk from the Warrawee Station. The journey will take approximately 1 hour.

**Accommodation:** There are a limited number of single rooms with ensuites available at a small surcharge (see registration form). They will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The other rooms are twin shares. If you have someone you would like to share with, please let the registrar know. All rooms include linen and a bath towel. If you want to be accommodated at the conference, you MUST book by July 2.

**Staying offsite?** – Please organise yourself: The price will be AUD 300 less and does not include breakfast.

This specific training in medical/therapeutic work includes reflective practice that can be intense or even overwhelming for some people. It could also aggravate certain predisposition to illnesses. **Cancellation Policy:** Participants cancellation requests must be received in writing (emailed and received, or postmarked) before June 17, 2016 for a full refund, less a \$100 cancellation fee. Cancellation requests received after June 17 will not be eligible for a refund, but another person may be substituted, for a \$50 administration fee. Telephone cancellations cannot be honoured. Email cancellations will be promptly acknowledged by return email; until then you cannot assume they have been received.
