Dear friends,

Confucius (551-479 BC) already said that there were three ways of learning: through imitation, that is the simplest; through insight, that is the most difficult; through experience, that is the bitterest. Anthroposophy contributes to all three of them — many things from Waldorf education, medicine, agriculture, banking and ecological engagement have been and are imitated. When we experience bitterness in life, anthroposophical perspectives can provide orientation regarding the necessary learning processes. But the royal path is to create the conditions for doing good through insight.

Thus for example the first anthroposophical paediatrician, Wilhelm zur Linden (1896-1972), and anthroposophical GPs were able to embark "out of insight" on a path of how to deal with vitamin D substitution and the use of antipyretics and antibiotics which was not followed by conventional medicine until decades later on the basis of scientific studies. While the unphysiological nature of the recommended vitamin D3 stoss therapy strategy was recognised relatively quickly also by conventional medicine, it was not until the late 1970s that the immunostimulating effect of fever was pointed out and the latest paediatric textbooks said that only the inexperienced paediatrician would immediately prescribe a suppository for every fever. As far as the use of antibiotics was concerned, however, the paediatricians had to wait until the 1990s until studies showed that not even every infection of the middle ear needed to be treated with antibiotics.

The physiological way of thinking of anthroposophic medicine needs to become part of academic discourse because it promotes learning through insight and does not expose people to unnecessary treatment and side effects. These and other perspectives have led to the holding of a series of scientific colloquia in the Medical Section at the Goetheanum until 2024, the first of which will take place from 11–13 March 2016, starting at 20.00 on the first day and finishing at 12.30 on the last. Here the main question is: what can we do to make a contribution in medical terms to the scientific acceptance of anthroposophy in the academic world and the associated ability to quote Rudolf Steiner? Dr Matthias Girke, Prof. Dr Peter Heusser, Prof. Dr. Wolf-Ulrich Klünker, PD Dr Harald Matthes, Prof. Dr Peter Matthiessen, Prof. Dr Peter Selg, Dr Johannes Weinzirl and Prof. Dr. Ursula Wolf have agreed to participate. Programme and registration will be published shortly. Similarly the detailed programme for the joint study conference on the medical lectures Physiology and Healing (GA 314) will be available soonest which will take place from 15–16 January 2016 with Peter Selg, Matthias Girke and Michaela Glöckler.

On 26 September 2015 the 40th anniversary of the Filder Clinic/Stuttgart was celebrated attended by the clinic founders Manfred Weckenmann and Jürgen Schürholz.

- 1. According to the regulations in force, only those may work with patients who have never been charged under law with any misconduct against dependent persons. That is certified by a criminal record certificate which can be applied for online with an electronic identity card and PIN.
- 2. Professional liability insurance is strongly recommended. In many hospitals whose staff look after refugees outside the immediate establishment the general professional liability insurance of the house applies. It should however be ascertained beforehand whether this is the case.
- 3. The accident insurance of the employer's liability insurance association takes effect in the following situation: "If helpers undertake tasks on instruction of the city or municipality which fall within the remit of the local authority, they are covered by the relevant accident insurance fund."
