As a House of the Word the first Goetheanum was built, and eurythmy developed hand in hand with the development of the structural form. The fire at New Years Evening 1922/23 destroyed the collaborative work of people from many different countries, who were connected to anthroposophy and who had been carving and working together even during the First World War. What was allowed to have an earthly form for a short amount of time was through the fire indelibly inscribed into the cosmic world-ether. The movement forms of eurythmy though will be alive in the world forever, when human beings out of free will connect with cosmic formative forces according to the indications of Rudolf Steiner and move in eurythmy..

The Healing Power of the Living Word was given to us with the Eurythmy Therapy Course in 1921. The ending lecture, given to the participating physicians on April 18th, includes a visionary demand, to further develop one's own cognition step by step to capture the real physiology of the threefold human organism, in order to perceive and understand the effect of eurythmy therapy in the self organization of the human being more clearly in the future .
