Professor Avni Sali is often referred to as the Father of Integrative Medicine in Australia. In 1996 he became the founding head of The Graduate School of Integrative Medicine at Swinburne University, Melbourne. In 2009 he established the National Institute of Integrative Medicine (NIIM) taking up the role of Director. Professor Sali has also been the Head of the University of Melbourne's Department of Surgery at Heidelberg Hospital. In 2016 Prof Sali was appointed a Member of the Order (AM) in the General Division of the Order of Australia. Professor Sali has been honoured for "significant service to integrative medicine as an educator, clinician and researcher, and to professional education."

Avni will share current initiatives in integrative care underway within NIIM, concentrating on its work within the field of oncology.

Dr Christian Grah is the Deputy Senior Physician of Internal Medicine, with specialisation in Pulmonology at Havelhöhe Hospital - an integrative hospital in Berlin. Christian leads the working group for respiratory medicine at Havelhöhe's Research Centre. He is a member of the DAMID (Europe's Anthroposophic Medical Association) and has a particular interest in the specialised needs of lung cancer patients within the physician - patient relationship.

Christian will give an overview of the care and treatment of lung cancer within the integrative hospital setting, highlighting the advantages integrative medicine offers to patient experience and outcome.
