In 2011 Prof. Dr. Peter Heusser and Mr. Peter Meister initiated a working group "Arbeitskreis Evaluation Anthroposofische Heilmittel" at the University Witten-Herdecke. The main goal of this group of anthroposophic researchers, and healthcare professionals is to cooperate in order to make it possible on the long term that (1) the anthroposophic therapies receive a proper scientific foundation and (2) will remain available for the healthcare system.
