

## 2011 IVAA annual accounts and 2012 budget

In comparison to the previous year the IVAA annual accounts show a clear decrease of the deficit to CHF 9,472.39. That this deficit occurred nevertheless was caused on the one hand by the fact that in spite of the mark up agreed at the members' assembly, the member's contributions did not in total amount to a sufficient increase. In addition to this, the negotiations with the trusts took more time than anticipated due to a variety of reasons. As a consequence the revenue projected for 2011 has not been achieved.

Aware of these facts, the IVAA Council has generated a bit less expenditure than last year in most areas [travel, locum cover, administration], in order not to further add to the annual deficit.

As can be readily seen, the 2012 budget in many areas differs essentially from figures of the 2011 annual account. This is related to concrete pledges for financial support by the Trusts within the "2012-2016 IVAA Europe Project" framework, which are reflected in the figures of the 2012 Budget. Thanks to this, activities in the Brussels office can be strengthened, and also new underpinning measures with professionals can be realised. These serve the aim of the Europe Project: to provide anthroposophic medicine with a legal political anchor in the years to come.

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
