

IVAA council proposal for an amendment of Articles 2 and 11 of the constitution

Amendmentproposal: Replacing current article 2 by a new article 2

Art. 2 (current)

Article 2 The society's objective is:
to represent anthroposophic medical associations at international level,
to provide mutual help and support in securing legal safeguards for anthroposophically extended medicine,
to coordinate activities of international importance for anthroposophic medical associations.

Art. 2 (new)

The society represents the anthroposophical doctors' associations internationally in all legal and political affairs. The society carries out this task within the context of the international anthroposophic medicine coordination, IKAM, the working collegueship of the Medical Section of the School for Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum.

Reason: Adjusting the constitution to reflect the actual work area of the IVAA

Amendmentproposal: Amendment Art. 11

Art. 11 (current)

Article 11 The Council.
The Council consists of three to seven persons, and no majority of members from any one country is allowed. The delegates elect the Council for a period of three years. The delegates likewise elect the chairman of the Council for a period of three years. Council members are eligible for re-election thereafter.

Art .11 (new)

The Council.
The Council consists of at least three persons, and no majority of members from any one country is allowed. The delegates elect the Council for a period of three years. The delegates likewise elect the chairman of the Council for a period of three years. Council members are eligible for re-election thereafter.

Reason: The increasing challenges of IVAA Council work in terms of both time and manpower require a possible extension of the Council to more than 7 persons.
