

## New Post Graduate Therapeutic Art and Artistic Training

The Sienna Academy training began in 2008 and will have completed its second full round by October 2015. The training is taught in accordance with the method and insights of Liane Collot d'Herbois, based on the colour research of Goethe and Rudolf Steiner. Students come from far and wide: Thailand, Japan, China, India, New Zealand and many distant parts of Australia. From 2016 onwards the training will be newly formed into a shorter post graduate training which will take 2.5 to 3 years to complete.



It is taught in 2 blocks of 6 weeks a year; each block is made up of three x 2 week modules. There are 14 modules with a different colour focus each time.

Medical lectures and other specialist subjects form an integral part of the training; students may access these in their own locality,

Training hours and curriculum are in line with the recommendations of the European Academy.

### All modules address 3 aspects:

- 1) Training the artistic abilities of the student
- 2) Training the individual student's development as a painting therapist
- 3) Training the therapist/ client working relationship
